

## Class for a 3-D look table runner

This runner looks complicated, but if you follow the pattern carefully and chain sew, it will come out looking great. I will be teaching the class along with a few other members. During an experiment this summer, most attendees finished construction of the top. We had a few beginner sewists, and very advanced ones. Suzanne Sterrett from MT was in this summer and, wanted to see if this could be taught with with people who had a variety of experiences.

You may want to pre-cut fabrics ahead of time and I will give you the pattern at the January or February meeting. It is made of squares and half square triangles. I will bring a few examples to show you in January and February.

The workshop will be on February 22, 9:30-2:30. The cost is \$15.00 which includes the pattern and the room rental. The pattern will include a table runner size to a King sized bed. It will be at St. James Lutheran Church, on 170 McMillian, in Grosse Pointe Farms.

We have parking for 8 cars in the small lot next to the church, and several in the back of the church. If you park in the lot, you must get a flier to put in your car window (back window is best), so you won't be ticketed. Please see either Margaret or myself for the flier and tape. No one has been ticketed since the church came up with this plan. You can also park in front of the church, or in Richard Elementary School's parking lot. You will have to enter in the rear of the church, as there are no stairs for you to climb with your machine. (Furnace has been fixed-hurray!)

Please bring the following:

1. Your fabric, and if you precut, please bring a swatch of each to help with the pattern.
2. Sewing machine, thread, scissors. etc. Pins are very important. Small baggies, help keep the pattern pieces separated. We will have a cutting table and two ironing stations and a design wall.
3. Your lunch. There are several restaurants across the street, if you'd prefer their lunch selection. Water, coffee and tea will be provided. If you wish to bring a snack to share, that would be great.
4. Please, please, bring your patience and pity on me, as it has been a long time since I have taught a class 😊

We have plenty of room. Once we accommodated 20. If we have over that amount, we are able to spill over into another room if necessary..
