Supply List

Since we will be exploring different styles of face-making, it will be better to have a large variety of scraps rather than any yardage. This is an experimental adventure, so nothing is set in stone, and nothing is wrong! These faces will be small—not larger than a fat quarter—and will be built on a foundation of your background fabric. I will be bringing a large scrap basket, so don't worry about having enough choices. We will have lots from which to choose!

Background fabric—not larger than a fat quarter, and anything goes!

Scraps, scraps and more scraps—may be any combo of plain fabric or pre-fused scraps.

Yarns, lace, ric-rac, ribbon, etc.--to use for embellishing.

Pencil, eraser

Glue stick

Scissors for fabric and paper, regular sewing notions

Sewing machines—couching foot is very useful!

Irons, or ironing stations at venue

Variety of threads to blend or contrast with your fabric.

Optional: fabric markers

Imagination, sense of humor and willingness to play!

The workshop will be held at St. James Lutheran Church, 170 McMillan Rd, Grosse Pointe Farms 48236. For parking, turn into the alley before the church, parking is on the side of the church or behind the church. Bring your own lunch, there is a couple places for food close by.
