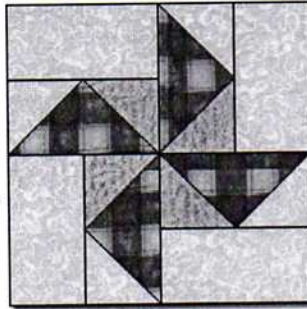

It's a scrap delight ! I thought it was probably about time that we use up some of those extra scraps of fabric from all of the other projects!

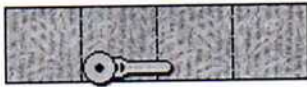

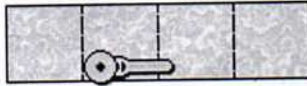
** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



First mark and cut the Color 1 3-1/2" x 26" strip into four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...



Then mark and cut the Color 2 3-1/2" x 14" strip into four 3-1/2" squares...



Next mark and cut the Color 3 3-1/2" x 14" strip into four 3-1/2" squares...

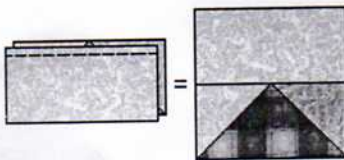


Now mark and cut the Color 3 3-1/2" x 26" strip into four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...

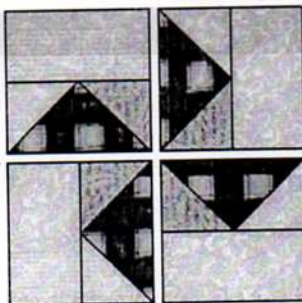
Use off white for color #3



Place a Color 3 3-1/2" square right sides together atop a Color 1 rectangle, with all edges aligned. On the back of the top square lightly draw a diagonal line in the direction shown at left. Sew ON this line. Cut off the excess seam allowance, and press the remainder towards the Color 3 triangle. repeat this procedure with a Color 2 square on the other end of the rectangle. Make four of these units...



Sew a Color 3 rectangle to each of the previously made units along the long top edge, using a SCANT 1/4" seam. press seam allowances towards the Color 3 rectangles. Make four of these units...on to



Piece the block by pivoting each of the previous units and sew together as shown at left. Alternate pressing directions with ea addition. ...and there you have it! :o) Great Job!!
