Unfinished Object Challenge

Do you need some motivation to complete those UFO's (Unfinished Objects) that are overtaking your sewing space? Then this is the challenge for you!!

Pick 6 of your UFO's that you want to complete in 2011/2012 and list them in no particular order. **Every other month** we will pick a number and the corresponding number of your list will be the UFO you will work on. If you bring the completed quilt or garment **and** show it at Show and Tell in the **designated month**, your name will be entered in a drawing for some nice prizes in May. But even if you do not win a prize, think of what a winner you will be to have those UFO's finally completed!!

FAQ'S

1. How can I participate?

Answer: Complete two (2) UFO Challenge forms and return one by the October meeting. Keep the second copy for your records. Number your UFO's 1-6. For each UFO, write the name of the quilt or garment and a fairly detailed description of each item (colors, pattern, approximate size, etc.) and what needs to be done to complete each item (add borders, sandwich and quilt, sew on a label, etc.)

2. What if I don't have 6 UFO's?

Answer: Write down as many as you have leaving some numbers blank. The month we draw your "blank number" you can get a head start on another project.

3. How will I know if my UFO's are acceptable for the challenge?

Answer: As a MINIMUM, you must need to add binding and label for your project to be considered a UFO for this challenge.

4. Can I substitute one UFO for another?

Answer: No—that is why they are numbered and why we have a copy of your list!

5. How will I know which number to work on?

Answer: The number will be chosen at a guild meeting and will be printed in the next newsletter. For example, the first number will be drawn in October, printed in the next newsletter, and your completed project will be shown in November.

6. What if I cannot come to the meeting to show my project or I do not have my project in my possession?

Answer: The **actual** quilt or garment **MUST BE SHOWN IN THE DESIGNATED MONTH**. If you cannot be there, find someone to show it for you.

7. How do I know if my UFO is complete?

Answer: A completed project means "NO ADDITIONAL WORK" is needed to display, use, or wear the item. A label must be affixed to the item. Waivers may be given for dolls or home dec items that do not have a suitable place for a label.

8. On the day the completed UFO is due, what do I do?

Answer: Bring the completed project to the UFO Challenge table at the Guild Meeting, get your name checked off, put your name in for the drawing, and show your project at Show and Tell.

We hope you will join us in this fun challenge for 2011/2012!
