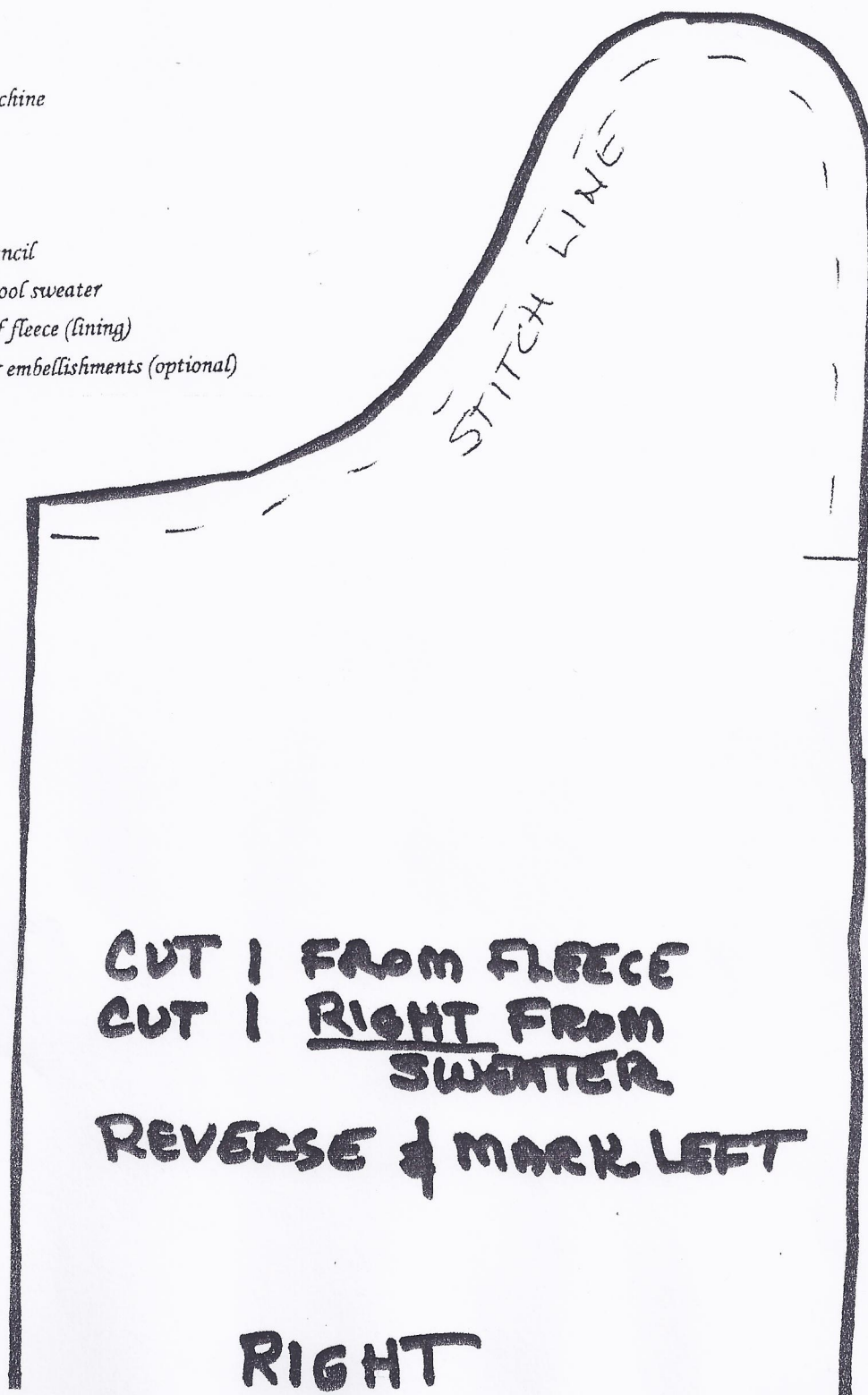


Wool Mitten Class:

To felt sweater: Purchase a 100% wool sweater. Sweaters with less wool can be used; however, they may not felt as well. A ladies medium to large or a man's sweater will work best do to shrinkage. Wash in hot water and either let it air dry or use a clothes dryer. It depends on the type of wool sweater you purchase how quickly it will felt, so watch it carefully. It is best if the rubbing is not too wide so it can be used for the cuff of the mitten. Cables and patterns work well. We will match them to make a pair or you can mix and match sweaters and colors to make the mittens interesting.

Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- Scissors
- Thread
- Pins
- marking pencil
- A felted wool sweater
- 1/3 yard of fleece (lining)
- Buttons or embellishments (optional)






STITCH LINE

CUT 1 FROM FLEECE
CUT 1 RIGHT FROM
SWEATER

REVERSE & MARK LEFT

RIGHT



FRONT OF
GLOVE

USE FLEECE FOR
LINING
($\frac{1}{2}$ YD)

USE SWEATER THAT
HAS BEEN FELTED
IN HOT WATER
(MED-LRG SIZE)
(100% WOOL)

CUT 2 FROM FLEECE
CUT 2 FROM SWEATER

CUFF 4" LONG
USE END OF
SLEEVE OR BOTTOM
OF HEM
