

**STEP 2** HOMEsweetHOME

A Judy Hopkins Mystery

Join the 2-7/8" LIGHT half-square triangles and the 5-1/4" DARK quarter-square triangles to make 8 Flying Geese units as shown.



Make 8.

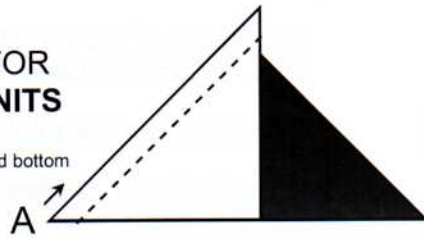
See the stitching and pressing tips at the right.

The units should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (raw edge to raw edge) when sewn.

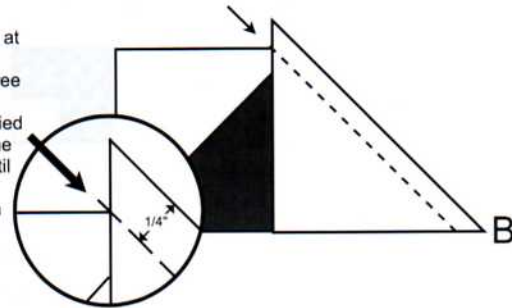


**STITCHING TIPS FOR FLYING GEESE UNITS**

1. Join left-hand triangle: Match points (A) and bottom edges; sew in direction of arrow. Press seam toward smaller triangle.



2. Join right-hand triangle. Start at arrow. Your 1/4" seam should EXACTLY intersect the 90-degree angle where the two smaller triangles meet, as in the magnified portion of the drawing. Adjust the position of the loose triangle until the seam lines up correctly. Take a few stitches, then match points (B) and finish stitching the seam. Press seam toward smaller triangle.

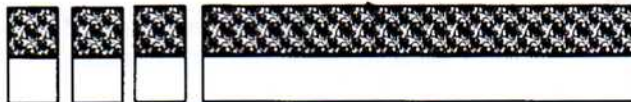


**STEP 3** HOMEsweetHOME

A Judy Hopkins Mystery

1. Join the 1-1/2" x 18" LIGHT strip and the 1-1/2" x 18" DARK strip to make 1 strip unit as shown. Press the seam toward the DARK fabric. The strip unit should measure 2-1/2" wide (raw edge to raw edge) when sewn.

From this strip unit, cut 8 segments, 1-1/2" wide.



Make 1 strip unit. Cut 8 segments 1-1/2" wide.
