

Here is updated information regarding NQD. Please let one of us know if you are coming so we can have tables and chairs for everyone.

The National Quilt Day committee was able to get a place to sew on March 11th. We know this is a week before the official day, but free places with good lighting were difficult to find. We would like to put a sign out on the church to invite people in the community to drop in to see what we are doing. We would be on the first floor. If you use the entrance from the parking lot in the back of the church, there are NO steps. There is a small incline to the door, and everything is on the first floor. I have checked this twice! If the parking lot requires a ticket to park, I have a stamp and you can then park for free.

We are so fortunate to have Diane Hubble and Renee Steinacker who will demonstrate a strip-quilt as you go, and a half circle quilt, which is also a quilt as you go. They have supplied lists for these two quilts, should you wish to sew one.

Please park in the back public lot, or in Richard School's parking lot.

We will provide a few ironing boards and irons. We will get the cords from our group.

We are hoping to complete some of the precut charity quilts, which will be sent to Gianna House. If you need to get that binding on your quilt for the quilt show, you can certainly do that, too!

Directions in brief:

If coming from I-94, get off Moross exit.

Go past St. John's Hospital, Mack, Chalfonte and turn Right onto Kercheval.

Travel @ 1 mile. There will be a small shopping area. At the end of the first section there is a light. Make a right.

You will see St. James on the right and Richard Elementary on the left.

The alley to the parking lot comes up quickly on the Right. Turn left into the public parking lot.
