

## Quilts from the Heart Show Quilt Entry Rules

Location: Roseville Recreation Center 18185 Sycamore Roseville MI 48066

- A quilt is defined as multi-layered and quilted or tied. Crazy quilts, cathedral windows and yo-yo quilts would be the only exceptions.
- · Quilts cannot be commercially made. Fleece blankets and fleece panels will not be considered a quilted item.
- Quilt entries must be completely finished, clean and in good condition.
- An entry form must be completed for any item you plan to enter, even if the item is not completed by the deadline to turn in forms.
- All quilts, 48 inches or larger, must have a sleeve sewn to the back of the quilt at the top, so the quilt can
  be safely hung in the show. The sleeve must be at least 6 inches in diameter.
- Include any unusual or interesting information about your quilt on the entry form. If your quilt was
  professionally quilted, provide the name of the quilter.
- If your entry is part of a group or a class we will try to hang them together. Indicate the name of the class
  or group project on the entry form.
- Attach the YELLOW copy of the completed form to the back of the quilt or clothing at the lower right hand corner. Use SAFETY PINS to attach the form, preventing damage to your entry and injury to the workers.
- Mail the WHITE part of the form to Virginia Froehlich, 8537 Voigt Ave., Grosse Ile MI 48138 by MARCH 17, 2015.
- · LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OR HUNG IN THE SHOW
- All entries must be delivered to the Roseville Recreation Center between 2:00 pm and 6:00 pm on Thursday, April 16, 2015. If you are unable to deliver your quilt during this time frame, call Jill Stiger (586-243-5320), Sue Richter (586-412-9577) or Nancy Watson (586-781-9377)
- All entries that are exhibited will remain on display until the show closes. NO EXHIBIT CAN BE REMOVED BEFORE SATURDAY, APRIL 18 AT 6:00 PM
- · The owner or designate must have the PINK copy of the entry form to receive the quilt or clothing entry
